Portage Work Experience Program - Participant Application Form

Portage Work Experience is an employment program offered through Portage Learning and Literacy Centre and is designed to help youth overcome barriers to employment. Participants are compensated at minimum wage for completing 1 to 2 weeks (total 30 or 60 hours, as training is 6 hours a day, 5 days per week) of pre-employment training, followed by approximately 14 to 16 weeks (up to 560 hours) of full-time work experience. Through this program, participants will be able to develop a broad range of skills and knowledge relevant to the current and future labour market.
